The MPA program highly recommends that MSW students take SW 6303 Child Welfare Leadership course as an elective, offered spring semester. Also, MPA classes are taught more than one time per year, including summer semester. Joint Degree students should consult with the MPA coordinator, Melissa Hall, when changing proposed semesters for MPA classes, and Judy Parker in the MSW office must be notified to help keep the Program of Study up to date.

**Students in the fall of their second year will receive information on all concentrations and graduate certificates to determine their choice(s) of focus during their third year program of study.**

**Beginning fall semester 2015, all students in the second concentration year of study must take one advanced practice class as an elective in any other concentration. These classes can be 1, 2, or 3 credit hours, depending on the concentration.**

**Students must receive a grade of C+ or better in any classes needed for graduation or to go on to the next class in any sequential series of classes (e.g. SW 6001/6002 and SW 6140 /6240 and SW 6120/SW 6220) and must maintain a cumulative 3.0 GPA to be in good academic standing.**
