Comprehensive Exam: After completing PBHLT 6100, 6300, 6400, 6500, 6600, 6700, and 6550,

students must pass the Certified in Public Health (CPH) exam. The exam is offered year-round but students must be registered for a minimum of three credit hours during the semester the exam is taken. Contact your Academic Advisor to obtain a voucher code for payment.

Capstone: Students are eligible to enroll in

PBHLT 6900 Capstone only after they have completed six of the seven other core courses (PBHLT 6100, 6300, 6400, 6500, 6550, 6600 and 6700). Only one core course can be taken concurrently with PBHLT 6900 Capstone. **6550 MUST be taken before capstone.**
